The Governor of Punjab is pleased to decide further that the benefit of revised pension/family pension envisaged in para 4.2 of the aforesaid letter will be available for fixation of pensioner/family pensioner of teachers and equivalent cadres in Government colleges in the State. A table of revised pension/family pension based on the Revise Scale of Pay+Academic Grade Pay effective from 1.1.2006 corresponding to the pre-revised pay scale as contained in the Notification issued vide letter No.10/3/2009-Edu.I/3321 dated 2.9.2009 by the Department of Higher Education is enclosed herewith as Annexure B to facilitate the payment of revised pension/family pension.
