After considering the recommendations of the Fifth Punjab Pay Commission, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to decide that the Non-Practice Allowance, (NPA) shall be admissible to those categories of Homeopathic Medical Officers of the Department of Health and Family Welfare (Homeopathic System of Medicine) for which minimum qualification of a degree in Homeopathy from any of the Institutions mentioned in the Second Schedule and Third Schedule of the Homeopathic Central Council Act, 1973 (Central Act to 59 of 1973) with enrollment on State Register or the Central Register of Homeopathy is required. The grant of NPA shall be subject to the following conditions:-

- (a) The NPA shall be admissible @ 25% of Revised Basic Pay in the revised pay structure subject to the condition that pay plus NPA shall not exceed Rs. 85,000/-
 - (b) The NPA shall be treated as pay for the purpose of grant of Dearness Allowance, entitlement of Travelling Allowance/Daily Allowance and for calculation of retiral benefits only. For the sake of removal of doubts it is clarified that House Rent Allowance shall not be admissible on the NPA.
 - (c) The private practice shall be disallowed. The A.D. will devise an appropriate mechanism to ensure compliance of this condition.
2. These orders shall come into force w.e.f. 1st October, 2011.
